



Surrender Decision Report

1 Application details and outcome

1.1. Permit application details

1.2. Description of application

The Permit Holder has applied to surrender clearing permit CPS 10205/1, for the proposed clearing of 1 hectare of native vegetation within a 9.11 hectare footprint, within Lot 6307 on Deposited Plan 39948, Myalup, for the purpose of construction and operation of a Managed Aquifer Recharge (MAR) pilot.

The Permit Holder advised that the 'Managed Aquifer Recharge Pilot' project proceeded to detailed design phase at which point it was determined that it wasn't feasible and was terminated. Additionally, no clearing has been undertaken under this permit (DPIRD, 2025).

1.3. Decision on application

Decision area:	1 hectare of native vegetation within a 9.11 hectare footprint, as depicted in Section 1.5, below.

1.4. Reasons for decision

The application to surrender clearing permit CPS 10205/1 was made in accordance with section 51MA of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (EP Act) and was received by the Department of Water and Environmental Regulation (DWER) on 25 February 2025.

In making the decision, the Delegated Officer had regard that the clearing has not commenced under the clearing permit CPS 10205/1, and the Permit Holder was compliant with the conditions of the Permit.

After consideration of the above information, the Delegated Officer decided to accept the surrender of Clearing Permit CPS 10205/1.

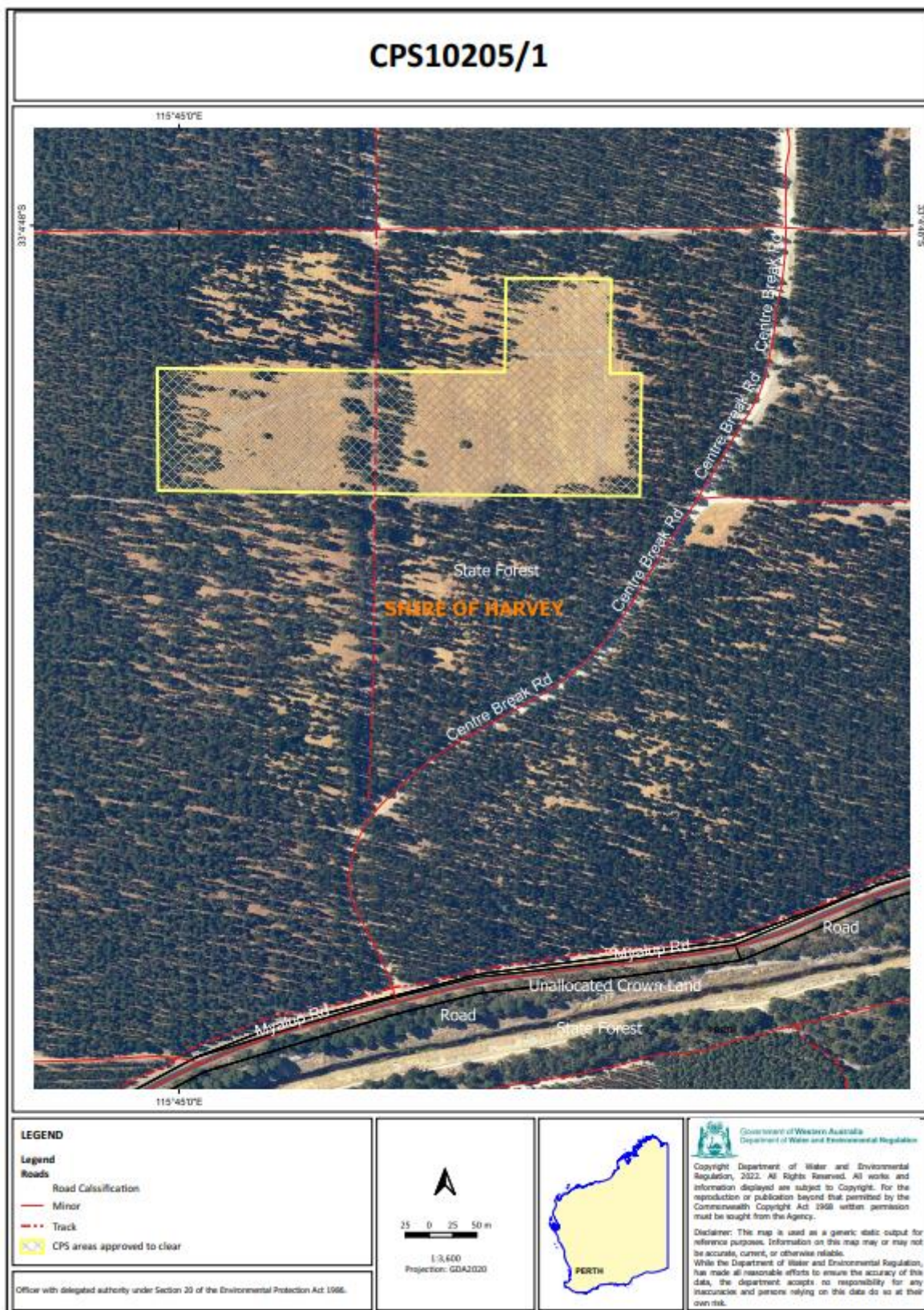


Figure 1 Map of the application area.

2 Assessment of surrender

2.1. Review of compliance with clearing permit conditions

A review of the aerial imagery indicates that no clearing has been undertaken within the area authorised to be cleared under CPS 10205/1 since the grant of this permit. This was confirmed by the Permit Holder.

Noting that no clearing was undertaken under CPS 10205/1 and the conditions of the Permit, it is considered that the Permit Holder was compliant with the permit conditions.
