### **AUTHORISED ACTIVITY**

1. Clearing of up to 15.5 hectares of native vegetation within the area cross-hatched yellow on attached Plan 1026/1.

### **CONDITIONS**

1. The permit holder shall plant a total of 6,500 Eucalyptus wandoo seedlings and 13,500 seedlings of one or more tree species that are native to the Avon Wheatbelt Region on the Property at a density of not less than 450 trees per hectare.
2. The permit holder shall not plant any seedlings under condition 1 within the area cross-hatched yellow on attached Plan 1026/1.
3. The permit holder shall plant the seedlings in accordance with condition 1 between the months of May and June inclusive, and shall complete the planting by 31 July 2007.
4. The permit holder shall attach a total of 30 constructed nesting boxes to trees that occur on the Property, prior to 31 July 2007. In attaching the constructed nesting boxes to trees the permit holder shall ensure that:
  - (a) each tree containing a constructed nesting box is more than 20 metres away from any other tree containing a constructed nesting box;
  - (b) each constructed nesting box is attached to the tree at a height of between 3 and 9 metres from the ground; and
  - (c) each tree to which a constructed nesting box is attached must have a diameter of greater than 30cm at the base.

5. The permit holder shall provide a report to the CEO prior to 30 September 2007. The report shall:  
(a) list the names and numbers of each tree species planted in accordance with conditions 1, 2 and 3; (b) state the location of each area where seedlings have been planted in accordance with conditions 1, 2 and 3; and (c) state the location of each constructed nesting box attached to a tree in accordance with condition 4.
6. In this Permit, Property means Lot 10188 on Plan 126023, Lot 18759 on Plan 84418, Lot 7454 on Plan 119883, Lot 16114 on Plan 165028, Lot 7455 on Plan 119884 and Lot 7372 on Plan 118919.
7. In this Permit, constructed nesting box means a box with the following features: (a) a width and length of 300mm or greater; (b) a height of 900mm or greater; (c) constructed using external plywood of greater than 12mm thickness; (d) containing at least 10 x 4mm drainage holes in the base; (e) lined with aviary mesh; (f) having an entrance hole of greater than 200mm in diameter; and (g) each of its outside surfaces being coated with a non-toxic, green or brown waterproof paint.
