1. INTRODUCTION

This procedure outlines the requirements for weed management. It applies to all personnel and contractors.

2. OBJECTIVES

The objectives are to:

- Ensure the percentage cover of weeds of National Significance or Declared Plants (DPIRD) on rehabilitated landforms is <15%
- Prevent the invasive spread of weeds

3. MANAGEMENT

Weed management measures are in Table 1.

Table 1: Weed management measures

Management Measure	Responsibility
Implement the weed management and control program	Environment
Inspect rehabilitated landforms for the presence of weeds and implement control measures i.e., direct treatment	
Record all weed management incidents / events and inspections in INX	
Inspect all new plant and equipment coming to site, as far as reasonably practicable, for weeds and excessive dirt / debris	Supervisors
Ensure all new plant and equipment complies with the Maintenance - Vehicle and Trailer Inspection Form and the Fixed Plant & Equipment Inspection (Weed Hygiene) Form	
Ensure all plant and equipment coming to / leaving site are, as far as reasonably practicable, free of weeds and excessive dirt / debris.	All personnel and contractors
