## LAND ON WHICH CLEARING IS TO BE DONE

LOT 20 ON DIAGRAM 53488

#### AUTHORISED ACTIVITY

Clearing of up to 1.7 hectares of native vegetation within the area cross-hatched yellow on attached Plan 1113/1.

### CONDITIONS

- 1) Fencing
  - (a) Prior to commencing clearing, the Permit Holder shall construct a fence enclosing the area cross-hatched red on attached Plan 1113/1.
  - (b) The fence shall be constructed and maintained so as to be adequate to exclude vehicle access and all classes of livestock.
- 2) Weed control
  - (a) The Permit Holder shall selectively remove or kill all *invasive weed* species at least once a year for the term of this Permit.
- 3) Fauna Management
  - (a) Prior to clearing within the area described in Authorised Activity above, the area shall be inspected by a fauna specialist who shall identify trees that contain hollows suitable to be utilised as habitat by fauna listed in the Wildlife Conservation (Specially Protected Fauna) Notice 2008.
  - (b) Prior to clearing, any habitat identified by condition 3(a) shall be inspected by a *fauna specialist* for the presence of fauna listed in the *Wildlife Conservation (Specially Protected Fauna) Notice 2008.*
  - (c) Prior to clearing the Permit Holder shall ensure that any fauna identified in condition 3(b) shall be removed and relocated by a *fauna clearing person*, in accordance with a licence issued by the Department of Environment and Conservation.
- 4) Records must be kept

The Permit Holder must maintain the following records for activities pursuant to conditions 1, 2 and 3 of this Permit:

- (a) In relation to the fencing and invasive weed management pursuant to conditions 1 and 2:
  - (i) A description of the fencing and invasive weed management activities undertaken.
- (b) In relation to fauna management pursuant to condition 3:
  - (i) The species relocated;
  - (ii) The number of individuals of each species relocated; and
  - (iii) The location and date where relocated fauna were released, using Geocentric Datum Australia 1994.

## 5) Reporting

The Permit Holder must provide to the CEO, on or before 30 June of each year, a written report of records required under condition 4.

## **DEFINITIONS**

The following meanings are given to terms used in this Permit:

fauna clearing person means a person who has obtained a licence from the Department of Conservation and Land Management, issued pursuant to the *Wildlife Conservation Regulations 1970* (as amended) authorising them to take fauna in order to carry out the approved clearing associated with this permit.

fauna specialist means a person with training and specific work experience in fauna identification or faunal assemblage surveys of Western Australian fauna.

invasive weed means Ehrharta species (Veldt grass), Gladiolus species, Carpobrotus edulis, Agave americana, Lupinus species, Pelargonium capitatum, Euphorbia terracina and Ursinia anthemoides.
