*Environmental Protection Act 1986, section 51KA*

The clearing of native vegetation is prohibited in Western Australia unless a clearing permit has been granted for the clearing or where a permit is not required (either due to a referral determination that one is not needed or because an exemption applies). A person who causes or allows unauthorised clearing commits an offence.

The proposed additional clearing totals 0.005 ha and is detailed in Appendix 1. The amendment brings the total clearing area to 0.215 ha.</p> <p><b>Proposed method of clearing</b> Mechanical.</p> <p><b>Purpose of clearing</b> The purpose of the clearing is to facilitate a rail signalling upgrade.</p> <p><b>Timeframe</b> Clearing will be completed by 16 October 2027 as per CPS 11153/1.</p> <p><b>Final land use</b> Rail reserve</p>

A survey was completed prior to lodging the original NVCP application to identify environmental values in the whole rail corridor associated with the Byford extension and other PTA works. The results of this survey were considered during the design stage to avoid and minimise impacts to environmental values.</p>

Part 4: Proposed amendments	
	<p>The original concept for the project included a traditional buried pipe which would have required trenching of a five-metre-wide corridor over eight kilometres and require approximately four hectares of clearing. Furthermore, the original design required clearing of several pits in SCP3b TEC. Underground cabling has been moved to the already cleared PTA access track to minimise clearing. The additional 0.005 ha of clearing proposed is the minimum required to connect the existing power line to the cleared track.</p> <p>The PTA also initially planned to place the project further south but relocated due to the environmental values identified in the surveys. PTA only applied for the minimum area required for the construction of the monopole and TSER with site accessible through already existing tracks.</p> <p><b>Mitigation Actions</b></p> <p>As part of the application for the granted permit (CPS 11153/1), the mitigation actions proposed include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• fauna spotting and relocation prior to clearing</li> <li>• demarcation of clearing boundaries and sensitive vegetation using bunting or</li> <li>• fencing</li> <li>• weed and dieback hygiene and washdown procedures</li> <li>• salvage of <i>Xanthorrhoea preissii</i> (grass trees) to replant in nearby areas.</li> </ul> <p>These mitigation actions will also apply to the proposed additional clearing area of 0.005 ha, as well as the following additional measures:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• clearing in the additional clearing area is limited to ground cover and shrubs only</li> <li>• no trees will be removed within the additional clearing area.</li> </ul>
