### LAND ON WHICH CLEARING IS TO BE DONE

WOOGENELLUP ROAD RESERVE BETWEEN ALBANY HIGHWAY AND RAIL CROSSING

#### **AUTHORISED ACTIVITY**

1. Clearing of up to 0.43 hectares of native vegetation within the area hatched yellow on attached Plan 1129/1.

### **CONDITIONS**

- 1. (a) The Permit Holder must revegetate the area cross hatched red on Plan 1129/1 by deliberately planting or seeding native vegetation that will result in a similar species composition, structure and density of native vegetation is similar to preclearing vegetation types in that area.
  - (b) The revegetation species shall consist of local endemic species found within 10km of the proposed clearing.
  - (c) The revegetation is to commence before 30 November 2007 and be completed by 30 September 2009 except for any reseeding required because of plant failure.
- 2. The permit holder shall provide a report to the CEO prior to 31 October 2009. The report shall:
  - (i) list the weight, species type and amount sown; and
  - (ii) list the species of living native plants per hectare as of October 2009 within the area revegetated under condition 1 of this permit.
