APPLICATION TO CLEAR NATIVE VEGETATION UNDER THE *ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT 1986* – ADVICE REQUEST

The Department of Water and Environmental Regulation (the department) has received an application under section 51E of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* (the EP Act) from Town of Victoria Park for an Area Permit that proposes to clear 0.5 hectares of native vegetation within Lot 705 on Deposited Plan 230206 (Crown Reserve 3694), Kensington, for the purpose of footings for two universal access ramps and egress point for emergency service vehicles. This application has been given the reference CPS 11498/1.

The department has found the application to be valid in accordance with section 51E of the EP Act, and accepted it for assessment. Following the assessment, the department will decide either to grant a clearing permit (including any specific conditions) or refuse to grant the clearing permit.

In order to facilitate the assessment of this application, the department is seeking advice and comment from the Department of Planning, Lands, and Heritage (DPLH) regarding the Bush Forever site 48 intersecting the application area.
