### **AUTHORISED ACTIVITY**

1. Clearing of up to 45 native trees within the areas hatched yellow on attached Plan 1179/1.

### **CONDITIONS**

- 1. The Permit holder shall ensure that stock is excluded from the areas hatched red on attached Plan 1179/1.
- 2. The Permit Holder shall not clear significant habitat trees.

#### Definitions:

Except as otherwise provided, terms used in this Permit have the meaning set out in the Environmental Protection Act 1986.

"Significant habitat trees" means mature trees that contain nesting hollows suitable for Baudin's cockatoo (Calyptorhynchus baudinii), Carnaby's cockatoo (Calyptorhynchus latirostris) and the forest red-tailed black cockatoo (Calyptorhynchus banksii naso). These trees will be standing jarrah (Eucalyptus marginata), marri (corymbia calophylla), karri (Eucalyptus diversicolor) or wandoo (Eucalyptus wandoo) which have a diameter at human chest height of greater than 700mm and contain hollow/s with an entrance greater than 10cm and a depth greater than 20cm.
