AUTHORISED ACTIVITY

1. Clearing of up to 60 hectares for the purposes of mineral exploration.

CONDITIONS

1. The Permit Holder shall provide a report to the Director, Environment, Department of Industry and Resources by the 31st of May each year setting out the records required under condition 2 of this permit in relation to clearing carried out within the areas cross hatched yellow marked on plan 1378/1.
2. The Permit Holder shall record the following for each instance of clearing:
 - a) the location where the clearing occurred, expressed as grid coordinates using the geocentric Datum of Australia 1994 coordinate system;
 - b) the area cleared in square metres,
 - c) the method of clearing,
 - d) the purpose of clearing and
 - e) the areas rehabilitated in square metres.
3. The Permit Holder shall not clear any native vegetation within the area cross hatched red on attached Plan 1378/1.
4. The permit holder shall reinstate the pre-existing ground levels and shape of any low lying seasonally inundated areas that are disturbed by the proposed clearing activities.
