AUTHORISED ACTIVITY

1. Clearing of up to 30 hectares for the purposes of a construction camp for the Cape Lambert port upgrade.

CONDITIONS

1. The Permit Holder shall record the following for each instance of clearing:
 - a) location where clearing occurred (using Geocentric Datum Australia 1994);
 - b) purpose of clearing;
 - c) area cleared in hectares;
 - d) area rehabilitated in hectares.
2. The Permit Holder shall provide a report to the Director, Environment, Department of Industry and Resources by 31 March each year setting out the records required under Condition 1 of this permit in relation to clearing carried out between 1 January and 31 December of the previous year.
3. The Permit Holder shall retain the vegetative material and topsoil removed by clearing in accordance with this Permit and shall, after the removal of the construction camp and associated infrastructure and prior to the expiry of the clearing permit, respread the vegetative material and topsoil on the cleared areas.
4. The Permit Holder shall provide a report to the Director, Environment, Department of Industry and Resources by 25 October 2010 setting out the records required under Condition 1 of this permit in relation to clearing and rehabilitation carried out between 1 January and 25 October 2010.
