PURPOSE FOR WHICH THE CLEARING MAY BE DONE

1. Clearing of up to 3.4 hectares for the purposes of Infrastructure maintenance.

CONDITIONS

- 1. The Permit Holder must not clear more than 3.4ha of native vegetation within the area marked red on attached Plan 1480/3.
- 2. The Permit Holder shall retain the vegetative material and topsoil removed by clearing in accordance with this Permit and shall, within one month of the area no longer being required for the purpose of infrastructure maintenance, lay the vegetative material and topsoil retained in accordance with this condition within the area solid filled red on attached Plan 1480/3.
- 3. The permit holder shall undertake revegetation of cleared areas within drainage lines and watercourses by:
 - (a) Deliberately planting and/or seeding native vegetation
 - (b) Ensuring only local provenance seeds and propagating material from within 10km of the area cleared are used to revegetate the area:
 - (c) Laying vegetative material and topsoil retained in accordance with condition 2 on the area.

DEFINITIONS

Drainage Line means a natural depression that carries surface water run off;

Watercourse has the meaning given in section 3 of the Rights in Water and Irrigation Act 1914; and

Native Vegetation has the meaning given to it in sections 3 and 51A of the Environmental Protection Act 1986 and regulation 4 of the Environmental Protection (Clearing of Native Vegetation) Regulations 2004.
