## **AUTHORISED ACTIVITY**

Clearing of up to 9.89 hectares of native vegetation within the area cross-hatched yellow on attached Plan 1495/1.

### CONDITIONS

## 1 Revegetation

- (a) Within six months of the area no longer being required for the purpose of Earthworks the Permit Holder must revegetate the area cross-hatched red on attached Plan 1495/1 by:
  - (i) Laying vegetative material and topsoil removed by *clearing* in accordance with this Permit.
  - (ii) Deliberately planting and/or seeding *native vegetation* that will result in a similar species composition, structure and density of native vegetation to pre-clearing vegetation types in that area;
  - (ii) Ensuring only local provenance seeds and propagating material from within 10km of the area cleared are used in the *revegetation* of the area;

### 2 Definitions

The following meanings are given to terms used in this Permit:

clearing has the meaning given to it in section 51A of the Environmental Protection Act 1986;

CPS 1495/1 30 March 2007

native vegetation has the meaning given to it in sections 3 and 51A of the Environmental Protection Act 1986 and regulation 4 of the Environmental Protection (Clearing of Native Vegetation) Regulations 2004;

**revegetation** means the re-establishment of a cover of *native vegetation* in an area such that the species composition, structure and density is similar to pre-clearing vegetation types in that area, and can involve regeneration, direct seeding and/or planting;
