AUTHORISED ACTIVITY

Clearing of up to 4.5 hectares of native vegetation within the combined areas shaded yellow on attached Plan 1504/3a, Plan 1504/3b, Plan 1504/3c, Plan 1504/3d and Plan 1504/3e.

CONDITIONS

1. Avoid, minimise etc clearing

In determining the amount of native vegetation to be cleared authorised under this Permit, the Permit Holder must have regard to the following principles, set out in order of preference:

- (a) avoid the clearing of native vegetation;
- (b) minimise the amount of native vegetation to be cleared; and
- (c) reduce the impact of clearing on any environmental value.

CONDITIONS

2. Dieback and weed control

When undertaking any clearing or other activity authorised under this Permit, the Permit Holder must take the following steps to minimise the risk of the introduction and spread of weeds and dieback:

- (a) clean earth-moving machinery of soil and vegetation prior to entering and leaving the area to be cleared;
- (b) ensure that no dieback or weed-affected soil, mulch, fill or other material is brought into the area to be cleared; and
- (c) restrict the movement of machines and other vehicles to the limits of the areas to be cleared.

Definitions

The following meanings are given to terms used in this Permit:

dieback means the effect of Phytophthora species on native vegetation;

dry conditions means when soils (not dust) do not freely adhere to rubber tyres, tracks, vehicle chassis or wheel arches;

fill means material used to increase the ground level, or fill a hollow;

mulch means the use of organic matter, wood chips or rocks to slow the movement of water across the soil surface and to reduce evaporation;

weed/s means a species listed in Appendix 3 of the "Environmental Weed Strategy" published by the Department of Conservation and Land Management (1999), and plants declared under section 37 of the Agriculture and Related Resources Protection Act 1976.



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

2.1. Existing environment and information

2.1.1. Description of the native vegetation under application

Vegetation Description

Beard Vegetation Association 3 consisting of Medium forest; jarrah-marri.

Beard Vegetation Association 51 consisting of Sedgeland; reed swamps, occasionally with heath.

Beard Vegetation Association 969 consisting of Mosaic: Medium forest; jarrah-marri / Low forest; jarrah.

(Shepherd et al, 2001).

Clearing Description

This application proposes to clear 4.5 hectares of native vegetation within 24.9 hectares or road reserves for road reconstruction and overlay, shoulder widening and shoulder maintenance. The proposed clearing is for 1m along a 14km stretch, up to a maximum of 2 metres. The maintenance will only be to the back slope of the drain.

Vegetation Condition

Very Good: Vegetation structure altered; obvious signs of disturbance (Keighery 1994)

To

Completely Degraded: No longer intact; completely/almost completely without native species (Keighery 1994)

Comment

Vegetation condition was established through aerial imagery (Albany 50cm Orthomosaic - Landgate 2007).

3. Assessment of application against clearing principles

The proponent has applied to extend the duration of the permit CPS 1504/2 to 31 December 2012. A review of current environmental information reveals no new additional information.
