AUTHORISED ACTIVITY

1. Clearing of up to 0.51 hectares of native vegetation within the area hatched yellow on attached Plan 1547/1.

CONDITIONS

1. Avoid, minimise etc clearing

- (a) In determining the amount of native vegetation to be cleared for the purposes of gravel pit rehabilitation the Permit Holder must have regard to the following principles, set out in order of preference:
 - (i) avoid the clearing of native vegetation;
 - (ii) minimise the amount of native vegetation to be cleared; and
 - (iii) reduce the impact of clearing on any environmental value.

2. Revegetation

- (a) The Permit Holder shall retain any vegetative material and topsoil removed by clearing in accordance with this Permit and shall, within one month lay vegetative material and topsoil on the gravel pit.
- (b) Prior to undertaking works pursuant to condition 2(a) the permit holder shall rip the gravel extraction pit floor and contour batters within the gravel extraction site.
