PURPOSE FOR WHICH THE CLEARING MAY BE DONE

1. The purposes of fire control.

CONDITIONS

1. The Permit Holder must not clear more than 0.74 ha of native vegetation within the area hatched yellow on attached Plan 1572/1.

2. Avoid, minimise etc clearing

In determining the amount of native vegetation to be cleared for the purpose of fire control the Permit Holder must have regard to the following principles, set out in order of preference:

- (i) avoid the clearing of native vegetation;
- (ii) minimise the amount of native vegetation to be cleared; and
- (iii) reduce the impact of clearing on any environmental value.

3. Weed control

When undertaking any *clearing*, or other activity pursuant to this Permit the Permit Holder must take the following steps to minimise the risk of the introduction and spread of *weeds*:

- (i) clean earth-moving machinery of soil and vegetation prior to entering and leaving the area to be cleared;
- (ii) restrict the movement of machines and other vehicles to the limit of the area to be cleared.
