PURPOSE FOR WHICH THE CLEARING MAY BE DONE

- Clearing for the purposes of fence line and track maintenance within the areas cross hatched yellow on Plan 1580/1a
- Clearing for the purposes of fence line and track maintenance within the areas cross hatched yellow on Plan 1580/1b
- 3. Clearing for the purposes of infrastructure maintenance, access tracks and fence line maintenance within the areas cross hatched yellow on Plan 1580/1c
- Clearing for the purposes of track and fire break maintenance within the areas cross hatched yellow on Plan 1580/1d
- 5. Clearing for the purposes of constructing an access track within the areas cross hatched yellow on Plan 1580/1e.

CONDITIONS

- 1. The Permit Holder shall not clear more than a total of one hectare of native vegetation as follows:
 - (i) Clearing of up to 0.25 hectares cross hatched yellow on Plan 1580/1a
 - (ii) Clearing of up to 0.2 hectares cross hatched yellow on Plan 1580/1b
 - (iii) Clearing of up to 0.4 hectares cross hatched yellow on Plan 1580/1c
 - (iv) Clearing of up to 0.05 hectares cross hatched yellow on Plan 1580/1d
 - (v) Clearing of up to 0.1 hectares cross hatched yellow on Plan 1580/1e
- 2. In determining the amount of native vegetation to be cleared the Permit Holder must have regard to the following principles, set out in order of preference:
 - (i) avoid the clearing of native vegetation;
 - (ii) minimise the amount of native vegetation to be cleared; and
 - (iii) reduce the impact of clearing on any environmental value.
