The permit holder is authorised to clear native vegetation for the above stated purposes, subject to the conditions of this Permit.

PART I - CLEARING AUTHORISED

1. Clearing authorised

The Permit Holder shall not clear more than 180.37 hectares in total and as described below:

- (a) Road construction within the Menzies North-West Road Reserve between SLK 150 to SLK 194, with SLK 0.0 commencing at the townsite of Menzies (17.6ha);
- (b) Road construction within the Mount Ida Road Reserve between SLK 2 to SLK 31, with SLK 0.0 commencing at the intersection of Menzies North-West Road and Mount Ida Road (11.76ha);
- (c) Road construction within the Kookynie-Malcolm Road Reserve between SLK 0 to SLK 3, with SLK 0.0 commencing at the townsite of Kookynie (0.6ha);
- (d) Road construction within the Kookynie Road Reserve in the area shaded yellow on attached Plan 1607/1 (1.3ha);

2. Application

This Permit allows the permit holder to authorise persons, including employees, contractors and agents of the permit holder, to clear *native vegetation* for the purposes of this Permit subject to compliance with the conditions of this Permit and approval from the Permit Holder.

3. Compliance with Assessment Sequence and Management Procedures

Prior to clearing any native vegetation under condition 1 of this Permit, the permit holder must comply with the Assessment Sequence and the Management Procedures set out in Part II of this Permit.

PART II – ASSESSMENT SEQUENCE AND MANAGEMENT PROCEDURES

4. Avoid, minimise etc clearing

- (a) In determining the amount of native vegetation to be cleared for the purposes of road upgrades the Permit Holder must have regard to the following principles, set out in order of preference:
 - (i) avoid the clearing of native vegetation;
 - (ii) minimise the amount of native vegetation to be cleared; and
 - (iii) reduce the impact of clearing on any environmental value.

5. Weed control

- (a) When undertaking any *clearing* the Permit Holder must take the following steps to minimise the risk of the spread of *weeds*:
 - (i) clean earth-moving machinery of soil and vegetation prior to entering and leaving the area to be cleared;
 - (ii) ensure that no weed-affected road building materials or other material is brought into, or transported from, the area to be cleared; and
 - (iii) restrict the movement of machines and other vehicles to the limits of the areas to be cleared.

6. Revegetation

- (a) The Permit Holder shall retain the vegetative material and topsoil removed by clearing in accordance with 1(e), 1(f), 1(g), 1(h), 1(i) and 1(j) of this Permit.
- (b) Within one month of the area no longer being required for the purpose of gravel extraction the permit holder must revegetate the area by laying vegetative material and topsoil retained in accordance with condition 6(a) on the area.
- (c) Prior to undertaking works pursuant to condition 6(b) the permit holder shall rip pit floor and contour batters within the gravel extraction site.

PART III - RECORD KEEPING AND REPORTING

7. Records must be kept

The Permit Holder must maintain the following records for activities done pursuant to this Permit, as relevant:

- (a) In relation to the *clearing* of *native vegetation* undertaken pursuant to condition 1:
 - (i) the location where the clearing occurred, recorded using Geocentric Datum Australia 1994;
 - (ii) the date that the area was cleared; and
 - (iii) the size of the area cleared (in hectares).
- (b) In relation to the *revegetation* of areas pursuant to condition 6:
 - (i) The location of any area revegetated recorded using Geocentric Datum Australia 1994;
 - (ii) A description of the revegetation activities undertaken; and
 - (iii) The size of the area revegetated (in hectares).

8. Reporting

The Permit Holder must provide to the *CEO*, on or before 30 June of each year, a written report of records requested under condition 7 and activities done by the Permit Holder under this Permit between 1 January and 31 December of the preceding year.

9. Definitions

The following meanings are given to terms used in this Permit:

CEO means the Chief Executive Officer of the Department of Environment;

clearing has the meaning given to it in section 51A of the *Environmental Protection Act* 1986:

EP Act means the Environmental Protection Act 1986;

native vegetation has the meaning given to it in sections 3 and 51A of the Environmental Protection Act 1986 and regulation 4 of the Environmental Protection (Clearing of Native Vegetation) Regulations 2004;

revegetation means the re-establishment of a cover of native vegetation in an area such that the species composition, structure and density is similar to pre-clearing vegetation types in that area, and can involve regeneration, direct seeding and/or planting.

road building material means rock, gravel, soil, stone, timber, boulders and water;

weed means a species listed in Appendix 3 of the "Environmental Weed Strategy" published by the Department of Conservation and Land Management (1999), and plants declared under section 37 of the Agricultural and Related Resources Protection Act 1976.
