AUTHORISED ACTIVITY

1. Clearing of up to 2 native trees within the area shaded yellow on attached Plan 1617/1.

CONDITIONS

- 1. The Permit Holder shall plant and maintain 20 seedlings within the area shaded red on attached Plan 1617/1. Seedlings shall be *Agonis flexuosa* (Peppermint).
- 2. The Permit Holder shall complete the planting of 20 Agonis flexuosa (Peppermint) seedlings required under Condition 1 by 30 June 2007.
- 3. Prior to commencing clearing authorised under this Permit, the Permit Holder shall trap and remove *Pseudocheirus occidentalis* (Western Ringtail Possum) in accordance with a licence issued by the Department of Environment and Conservation, until the Permit Holder reasonably believes that it has removed all *Pseudocheirus occidentalis* (Western Ringtail Possum) within the area authorised for clearing.
- 4. The Permit Holder must maintain records in relation to fauna management pursuant to condition 3 as follows:
 - i) The location of each habitat tree identified, recorded using Geocentric Datum Australia 1994;
 - ii) The species and number of each species relocated;
 - iii) The location and date where relocated fauna was released, using Geocentric Datum Australia 1994.
- 5. The Permit Holder must provide to the CEO a written report of records requested under condition 4 on completion of condition 3 and being at least three months prior to the expiry of the term of this Permit.
