### AUTHORISED ACTIVITY

1. Clearing of up to 120 *Banksia* trees within the area cross hatched yellow on attached Plan 1680/1.
2. Selective removal of native vegetation less than 1.0m in height within an area of 5.6 hectares cross-hatched yellow on attached Plan 1680/1.

### CONDITIONS

1. The Permit Holder shall not clear any native vegetation within the area cross hatched red on attached Plan 1680/1.
2. Avoid, minimise etc clearing;

In determining the amount of native vegetation to be cleared the Permit Holder must have regard to the following principles, set out in order of preference:

- (i) avoid the clearing of native vegetation;
- (ii) minimise the amount of native vegetation to be cleared; and
- (iii) reduce the impact of clearing on any environmental value.

### DEFINITIONS

The following meanings are given to terms used in this Permit:

*clearing* has the meaning given to it in section 51A of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986*;

*native vegetation* has the meaning given to it in sections 3 and 51A of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986*;
