AUTHORISED ACTIVITY

1. Clearing of up to 149 hectares of native vegetation within the area cross-hatched yellow on attached Plan 1704/2.

CONDITIONS

1. The Permit Holder shall retain the vegetative material and topsoil removed by clearing in accordance with this Permit.
2. The Permit Holder shall rehabilitate areas cleared under this permit to locally native vegetation.
3. As part of the rehabilitation of the areas cleared, the Permit Holder shall take the following measures:
 - (i) selectively remove or kill all plant species that are not native within the cleared site;
 - (ii) sow the cleared site with a seed mixture consisting of local native species found within a 15km radius of the site; and
 - (iii) the seed mixture shall be spread at a minimum rate of 1 kilogram per hectare.
4. The permit holder shall not allow any external soils, road base or vegetation on site unless tested free of *Phytophthora cinnamomi* contamination or sourced from a known *Phytophthora cinnamomi* free source.
5. All machinery and vehicles used during the clearing shall be cleaned of material that may be a source of *Phytophthora cinnamomi* contamination prior to entering the areas approved to clear.
6. The Permit Holder shall record the following for each instance of clearing:
 - (i) the location of where the clearing occurred, expressed as grid coordinates using the Geocentric Datum of Australia 1994 coordinate system;
 - (ii) the size of the area cleared in hectares;
 - (iii) the dates on which the area was cleared;
 - (iv) the area rehabilitated in hectares;
 - (v) the method of clearing; and
 - (vi) the purpose of clearing.

7. The Permit Holder shall provide a report to the Director, Environment Division, Department of Industry and Resources by 15 March 2009, demonstrating adherence to all conditions of this permit, and setting out the records required under Condition 6 of this permit in relation to clearing carried out within the duration of the permit.
