AUTHORISED ACTIVITY

1. Clearing of up to 4 (four) native trees within the area cross-hatched yellow on attached Plan 1865/2.

CONDITIONS

1. Fauna Management

- (a) Immediately prior to commencing clearing, the site shall be inspected by a *fauna specialist* and any fauna identified, including but not limited to, the Western Ringtail Possum (*Pseudocheirus occidentalis*), as utilizing the trees authorised for clearing under this Permit, shall be removed and relocated by a *fauna clearing person* to a location in the immediate vicinity but outside the area of the clearing operation.
- (b) All debris resulting from the clearing of the vegetation authorised under this Permit shall be removed immediately from the site after clearing and not stored or heaped in a way that could be used as fauna refuge.

2. Definitions

fauna specialist means a person with training and specific work experience in fauna identification or faunal assemblage surveys of Western Australian fauna;

fauna clearing person means a person who has obtained a licence from the Department of Environment and Conservation, issued pursuant to the *Wildlife Conservation Regulations 1970* (as amended) authorising them to take fauna in order to carry out the approved clearing associated with this permit.
