AUTHORISED ACTIVITY

1. Clearing of up to 830 native trees within the areas cross hatched yellow on attached Plans CPS 187/2-1 and CPS 187/2-2.

CONDITIONS

- 1. The permit holder shall revegetate the area cross hatched red on attached Plan CPS 187/2-1. The revegetation shall be established and maintained to an average planting density of 600 plants per hectare. The species shall consist of overstorey, midstorey and understorey species that are native to the area. Seed shall be sourced from within a 20 km radius of the property.
- 2. The Permit Holder shall selectively remove or kill all plant species that are weeds within the area cross hatched red on attached Plan CPS 187/2-1 during the months of June or July each year.
- 3. The Permit Holder shall retain mature trees with hollows found in situ within the area cross hatched yellow on attached Plans 187/2-1 and 187/2-2 and place within the area cross hatched red on attached Plan 187/2-1 by 1 January 2007 in consultation with CALM.

DEFINITIONS:

Except as otherwise provided, terms used in this Permit have the meaning set out in the Environmental Protection Act 1986.

"mature tree", for the purposes of this permit, means a native tree with a trunk greater than 30cm in diameter;

"weed", for the purposes of this permit, means a species listed in Appendix 3 of the "Environmental Weed Strategy" published by the Department of Conservation and Land Management (1999), and plants declared under section 37 of the *Agricultural and Related Resources Protection Act 1976*.
