RED BLUFF ROAD RESERVE (Kalbarri 6536)

PURPOSE FOR WHICH THE CLEARING MAY BE DONE

1. Clearing for the purposes of road widening.

CONDITIONS

- 1. The Permit Holder must not clear more than 1.0 hectares of native vegetation, within the area cross-hatched yellow on attached Plan 1884/1.
- Avoid, minimise etc clearing

In determining the amount of native vegetation to be cleared for the purpose of road widening the Permit Holder must have regard to the following principles, set out in order of preference:

- (i) avoid the clearing of native vegetation;
- (ii) minimise the amount of native vegetation to be cleared; and
- (iii) reduce the impact of clearing on any environmental value.
- 3. The Permit Holder shall retain the vegetative material removed by clearing in accordance with this Permit.
- 4. Within one month of the completion of the road widening and associated infrastructure works the Permit Holder shall lay the vegetative material retained under condition 3 on exposed soil within areas cross-hatched yellow on the attached Plan 1884/1.
- 5. The Permit Holder must maintain the following records for activities done pursuant to this Permit, as relevant:
 - (i) The location where the clearing occurred, recorded using Geocentric Datum Australia 1994;
 - (ii) The date that the area was cleared;
 - (iii) The size of the area cleared (in hectares); and
 - (iv) The date that the vegetative material was laid.

6. Reporting

The Permit Holder must provide to the CEO, on or before 30 June of each year, a written report of records required under condition 5 and activities done by the Permit Holder under this Permit between 1 January and 31 December of the preceding year.
