PURPOSE FOR WHICH THE CLEARING MAY BE DONE

Clearing for the purpose of extractive industry.

CONDITIONS

- 1. This Permit authorises the clearing of up to 20.75ha of native vegetation within the area cross hatched yellow on attached Plan 1959/2a.
- 2. The Permit Holder shall not clear native vegetation unless actively mining the area to be cleared within six months of the clearing.

3. Fencing

- (a) The Permit Holder shall construct a fence enclosing the areas cross hatched red on attached Plan 1959/2a.
- (b) The fence shall be constructed and maintained so as to be adequate to exclude vehicle access.
- (c) Construction of the fence shall be completed by 30 June 2008.

4. Protection of existing native vegetation

In respect to the area cross hatched red on attached Plan 1959/2b, the permit holder shall give an agreement to reserve under section 30B of the *Soil and Land Conservation Act 1945* in accordance with the following conditions:

- (a) native vegetation in the area subject to the agreement to reserve must not be cleared, excepting clearing required under the *Bush Fires Act 1954*;
- (b) the agreement to reserve is to be registered on the title of the property; and
- (c) the Permit Holder is to execute and return the agreement to reserve to the Commissioner of Soil and Land Conservation at least two weeks prior to the title to the land being transferred to another party, or in any event, by the 31 March 2009.

5. Reporting

- (a) The Permit Holder must notify the CEO in writing within one month of the fencing being completed in accordance with condition 3.
- (b) The Permit Holder must notify the CEO in writing within one month of the agreement to reserve being executed in accordance with condition 4.
