#### PURPOSE FOR WHICH THE CLEARING MAY BE DONE

1. Clearing for the purposes of re-alignment of a 132kV transmission line around the Gap Ridge Accommodation Camp.

### CONDITIONS

- 1. The Permit Holder can clear up to 16.23 ha of native vegetation.
- 2. In determining the amount of native vegetation to be cleared under this Permit the Permit Holder must have regard to the following principles, set out in order of preference:
  - (i) avoid the clearing of native vegetation;
  - (ii) minimise the amount of native vegetation to be cleared; and
  - (iii) reduce the impact of clearing on any environmental value.
- 3. When undertaking any clearing, or other activity pursuant to this Permit the Permit Holder must take the following steps to minimise the risk of the introduction and spread of weeds:
  - (i) clean earth-moving machinery of soil and vegetation prior to entering and leaving the area to be cleared;
  - (ii) ensure that no weed-affected road building materials, mulch, fill or other material is brought into the area to be cleared; and
  - (iii) restrict the movement of machines and other vehicles to the limits of the areas to be cleared.
- 4. The Permit Holder must maintain the following records for activities done in relation to the clearing of native vegetation undertaken pursuant to the purpose of clearing:
  - (i) the location where the clearing occurred, recorded using Geocentric Datum Australia 1994;
  - (ii) the date that the area was cleared; and
  - (iii) the size of the area cleared (in hectares).

5. The Permit Holder must provide to the CEO, on or before 30 August of each year, a written report of records required under condition 4 and activities done by the Permit Holder under this Permit between 1 January and 31 December of the preceding year.
