### **PURPOSE FOR WHICH THE CLEARING MAY BE DONE**

1. Clearing for the purposes of mineral production

### **CONDITIONS**

1. The Permit Holder must not clear more than 70 hectares of native vegetation within the area cross-hatched yellow on attached Plan 1997/1.
2. The Permit Holder shall record the following for each instance of clearing:
  - a) the location where clearing occurred, expressed as grid coordinates using the Geocentric Datum of Australia 1994 coordinate system;
  - b) the area cleared in hectares;
  - c) the dates cleared;
  - d) the method of clearing; and
  - e) the purpose of clearing.
3. The Permit Holder shall provide a report to the Director, Environment, Department of Industry and Resources (DoIR) by 30 June each year for the life of the permit setting out the records required under Condition 2 of this permit in relation to clearing carried out between 1 July and 30 June the previous year. This report can be submitted as an addendum to an Annual Environmental Report submitted to DoIR.
4. The Permit Holder shall retain the vegetative material and topsoil removed by clearing in accordance with this Permit.
5. The Permit Holder shall not clear any native vegetation within the area cross-hatched red on attached Plan 1997/1.

## Definitions

In this permit

**Annual Environmental Report** means a report produced as a requirement of tenement conditions under the *Mining Act 1978*.
