PURPOSE FOR WHICH THE CLEARING MAY BE DONE

1. Clearing for the purposes of mineral exploration.

CONDITIONS

- 1. The Permit Holder must not clear more than 0.05 hectares of native vegetation. All clearing must be within the area shown pink on attached Plan 2068/1.
- 2. The Permit Holder shall record the following for each instance of clearing:
 - (a) the location where clearing occurred, expressed as grid coordinates using the Geocentric Datum of Australia 1994 coordinate system;
 - (b) the area cleared in hectares;
 - (c) the dates cleared;
 - (d) the method of clearing;
 - (e) the purpose of clearing; and
 - (f) the area rehabilitated in hectares.
- 3. When undertaking any clearing, revegetation and rehabilitation, or other activity pursuant to this Permit, the permit holder must take the following steps to minimise the risk of the introduction and spread of weeds:
 - (a) Clean earth-moving machinery of soil and vegetation prior to entering and leaving the area to be cleared:
 - (b) Ensure that no weed-infected road building materials, mulch, fill or other material is brought into the area to be cleared; and
 - (c) Restrict vehicle movements to existing or newly constructed access tracks.
- 4. The Permit Holder shall retain all vegetative material and topsoil removed by clearing and within six months of clearing, the Permit holder shall rip the cleared areas and re-spread the topsoil and vegetative material over the ripped area.

5. The Permit Holder shall provide a report to the Director, Environment Division, Department of Industry and Resources by 15 March 2009, demonstrating adherence to all the Conditions of this permit and setting out the records required under Condition 2 of this permit, in relation to clearing carried out between 15 March 2008 and 15 March 2009.
