AUTHORISED ACTIVITY

1. Clearing of up to 7.07 hectares of native vegetation within the area cross hatched yellow on attached Plan 2109/1.

CONDITIONS

- 1. The Permit Holder shall not clear native vegetation unless actively mining the area to be cleared within six months of the clearing.
- 2. Fauna Management
 - (a) Prior to clearing within the area described in Authorised Activity above, the area shall be inspected by a fauna specialist who shall identify trees that contain hollows suitable to be utilised as habitat by fauna listed in the Wildlife Conservation (Specially Protected Fauna) Notice 2005.
 - (b) Prior to clearing, any habitat identified by condition 2(a) shall be inspected by a fauna specialist for the presence of fauna listed in the Wildlife Conservation (Specially Protected Fauna) Notice 2005.
 - (c) Prior to clearing the Permit Holder shall ensure that any fauna identified in condition 2(b) shall be removed and relocated by a *fauna clearing person*, in accordance with a licence issued by the Department of Environment and Conservation.
- 3. Records must be kept

The Permit Holder must maintain the following records Fauna Management pursuant to condition 2:

- (a) The species of fauna reasonably likely to utilise, or that have been observed utilising the habitat trees;
- (b) The species and number of each species relocated; and
- (c) The location and date where relocated fauna was released, using Geocentric Datum Australia 1994.

DEFINITIONS

fauna specialist means a person with training and specific work experience in fauna identification or faunal assemblage surveys of Western Australian fauna;

fauna clearing person means a person who has obtained a licence from the Department of Environment and Conservation, issued pursuant to the Wildlife Conservation Regulations 1970 (as amended) authorising them to take fauna in order to carry out the approved clearing associated with this permit.
