Lot 2 on Plan 29392 (Abercrombie Road POSTANS 6167)

AUTHORISED ACTIVITY

1. Clearing of up to 7.07 hectares of native vegetation within the area cross hatched yellow on attached Plan 2109/1.

CONDITIONS

1. The Permit Holder shall not clear native vegetation unless actively mining the area to be cleared within six months of the clearing.
2. Fauna Management
 - (a) Prior to clearing within the area described in Authorised Activity above, the area shall be inspected by a *fauna specialist* who shall identify trees that contain hollows suitable to be utilised as habitat by fauna listed in the *Wildlife Conservation (Specially Protected Fauna) Notice 2005*.
 - (b) Prior to clearing, any habitat identified by condition 2(a) shall be inspected by a *fauna specialist* for the presence of fauna listed in the *Wildlife Conservation (Specially Protected Fauna) Notice 2005*.
 - (c) Prior to clearing the Permit Holder shall ensure that any fauna identified in condition 2(b) shall be removed and relocated by a *fauna clearing person*, in accordance with a licence issued by the Department of Environment and Conservation.
3. Records must be kept
The Permit Holder must maintain the following records Fauna Management pursuant to condition 2:
 - (a) The species of fauna reasonably likely to utilise, or that have been observed utilising the habitat trees;
 - (b) The species and number of each species relocated; and
 - (c) The location and date where relocated fauna was released, using Geocentric Datum Australia 1994.

DEFINITIONS

fauna specialist means a person with training and specific work experience in fauna identification or faunal assemblage surveys of Western Australian fauna;

fauna clearing person means a person who has obtained a licence from the Department of Environment and Conservation, issued pursuant to the *Wildlife Conservation Regulations 1970* (as amended) authorising them to take fauna in order to carry out the approved clearing associated with this permit.
