## RE: APPLICATION FOR A CLEARING PERMIT - LOT 1 TEMPLE ROAD, PICTON

Please find enclosed herewith a completed formal Application for a Clearing Permit (Area Permit) submitted under provision of Section 51E of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* by *Thompson McRobert Edgeloe* acting on behalf of Southern Districts Estate Agency. Also enclosed in support of this application is a location plan detailing the extent of the proposed clearing and a cheque for the prescribed application fee of \$50.

The proposal aims to develop and extend the existing hard standing area of the site.

Proposed master plan attached, subject to approval.

#### 1.0 Location, Area and Ownership

The subject area of this application is located on Temple Road in Picton. (Figure 06412P-09).

The site is more accurately described as:

- Portion of the Dardanup Shire (subject of certificate of title volumes and folio numbers below). The land is owned by J & P Metals which comprises an area of approximately 24 hectares.
- Volume 1887 Folio 591

## 2.0 Current Landuse

The area of land subject to this application is currently zoned General Industry. The surrounding land is being progressively developed for industrial land use sites.

#### 3.0 Physical Environment

The remnant canopy of vegetation is found in small insolated areas.

The land has mostly low-dense grasses with small clusters of trees and shrubs.



## 4.0 Proposal

The three stands of vegetation associated with this application were separated from a previous clearing application which was approved under permit No. 1683/1. This permit identified the three areas as locations of possible DRF. A DRF study is being undertaken by an accredited firm in November in conjunction with this application.

It has been calculated that an area of approximately 0.4 Ha incorporating approximately15 large bushes/trees is required to be cleared to enable earthworking associated with creating the proposed extended hard standing area. The trees proposed to be cleared are shown within the clearing application area on the enclosed plan 06412-09.

Schedule 5 of the *Environmental Protection Act 1986* details 10 principles which guide application assessment under the new clearing application process. These principles generally require the conservation of native vegetation that:

- Provides a significant environmental function (eg significant ecological communities, riparian vegetation, linkage functions);
- If cleared, would cause appreciable land degradation;
- If cleared, would cause deterioration to the quality of surface water or ground water;
   and
- If cleared, would cause (or exacerbate) the incidence of flooding.

In considering the above principles and the natural characteristics of the subject land, the likelihood of the proposed clearing impacting upon or causing appreciable land degradation, deterioration of ground and surface water and increasing the incidence of flooding is considered remote.

Approval is therefore sought from the Department of Environment for the clearing of approx 0.4 ha of land, as depicted on the enclosed plan (*Figure 06412-09*).

The vegetation is not considered to form part of any significant environmental function and it is therefore considered appropriate to be able to clear the prescribed vegetation for the purpose of enabling earthworks and proposed extension of the existing Industrial site.
