
Iluka Eneabba Operations – Allied Tails Mining Proposal

This proposal is submitted in accordance with the requirements of Section 51 (Clearing of Native Vegetation) of the Environmental Protection Act (1986) as amended. The proposal is submitted to seek approval to mine within an area known as Allied Tails. The clearing form is attached with an application fee for \$200.

Mining at Eneabba is managed under the Mineral Sands (Eneabba) State Agreement Act (as amended) 1975. The Allied Tails proposal represents the continuation of a well established mining operation that has operated successfully since the mid 1970s. No change to mining or processing operations is required as a result of this proposal except the change in location. Iluka believes that the proposal can be adequately managed under the existing regulatory arrangements that include a range of environmental protection measures including annual reporting to the State.
