
PURPOSE FOR WHICH THE CLEARING MAY BE DONE

1. Clearing for the purposes of mineral exploration.

CONDITIONS

1. The Permit Holder must not clear more than 50 hectares of native vegetation within the area cross-hatched yellow on attached plan 2190/1.
2. The Permit Holder must record the following for each instance of clearing:
 - (a) the location where clearing occurred, expressed as grid coordinates using the Geocentric Datum of Australia 1994 coordinate system;
 - (b) the area cleared in hectares;
 - (c) the dates cleared;
 - (d) the method of clearing;
 - (e) the purpose of clearing; and
 - (f) the area rehabilitated in hectares.
3. For each instance of clearing recorded under condition 2, the Permit Holder shall, within 6 months of the completion of the activity for which the area was cleared, rehabilitate all cleared areas by re-shaping the surface of each cleared area using the topsoil removed during the clearing, so that the shape of the surface of the rehabilitated area is consistent with the shape of the surrounding 5 metres of uncleared land.
4. The permit holder shall not clear known populations of *Calotis latiuscula*, *Goodenia lunata* and *Stackhousia clementii* within the area cross hatched-yellow on attached plan 2190/1.

5. The Permit Holder shall provide a report to the Director, Environment Division, Department of Industry and Resources (DoIR) by 1 February each year for the life of the permit, demonstrating adherence to all other conditions of this permit and setting out the records required under Condition 2 of this permit in relation to clearing carried out between 1 January and 31 December of the previous year. This report can be included as part of the Annual Environmental Report submitted to DoIR.
