PURPOSE FOR WHICH THE CLEARING MAY BE DONE

1. Clearing for the purposes of Mineral Exploration

CONDITIONS

- 1. The Permit Holder must not clear more than 0.34 hectares of native vegetation. All clearing must be within the area cross-hatched yellow on attached Plan 2196/1.
- 2. The Permit Holder shall record the following for each instance of clearing:
 - (a) the location where clearing occurred, expressed as grid coordinates using the Geocentric Datum of Australia 1994 coordinate system;
 - (b) the area cleared in hectares;
 - (c) the dates cleared;
 - (d) the method of clearing;
 - (e) the purpose of clearing; and
 - (f) the area rehabilitated in hectares.
- 3. The Permit Holder shall not clear any specimens of the Genus *Eucalyptus*.
- 4. The Permit Holder shall not clear within 10 metres of a drainage line or a non-perennial watercourse.
- 5. The Permit Holder shall provide a report to the Director, Environment Division, Department of Industry and Resources (DoIR) by 30 September each year for the life of the permit, setting out the records required under condition 1 of this permit in relation to clearing carried out between 1 July and 30 August of the previous financial year. This report can be included as part of the Annual Environmental Report submitted to DoIR.
