

### PURPOSE FOR WHICH THE CLEARING MAY BE DONE

1. Clearing for the purpose of mineral production.

### CONDITIONS

1. The Permit Holder must not clear more than 92 hectares of native vegetation. All clearing must be within the area cross-hatched yellow on attached Plan 2205/1.
2. The Permit Holder shall stockpile topsoil and vegetative material to be used in rehabilitation.
3. The Permit Holder shall record the following for each instance of clearing:
  - a) the location where clearing occurred, expressed as grid coordinates using the Geocentric Datum of Australia 1994 coordinate system;
  - b) the area cleared in hectares;
  - c) the dates cleared;
  - d) the method of clearing;
4. The Permit Holder shall provide a report to the Director, Environment Division, Department of Industry and Resources prior to 22 March each year for the life of the permit demonstrating adherence to all the conditions of this permit and setting out the records required under condition 3 of this permit in relation to clearing carried out between 22 March 2008 and 22 March 2015.
