PURPOSE FOR WHICH THE CLEARING MAY BE DONE

1. Clearing for the purposes of mineral production.

CONDITIONS

1. The Permit Holder must not clear more than 8.2 hectares of native vegetation. All clearing must be within the area cross-hatched yellow on attached Plan 2234/1.
2. The Permit Holder shall record the following for each instance of clearing:
 - a) the location where the clearing occurred, recorded using Geocentric Datum Australia 1994;
 - b) the size of the area cleared (in hectares);
 - c) the dates that the area was cleared; and
 - d) the method of clearing.
3. The Permit Holder shall provide to the Director, Environment Division, Department of Industry and Resources, on or before 17 May each year for the life of the permit, a written report of records required under condition 2 of this permit, in relation to clearing carried out between 17 May 2008 and 17 May 2010.
