### PURPOSE FOR WHICH THE CLEARING MAY BE DONE

1. Clearing for the purposes of mining infrastructure.

### CONDITIONS

1. The Permit Holder must not clear more than 4.3 hectares of native vegetation. All clearing must be within the area cross-hatched yellow on attached Plan 2270/1.
2. The Permit Holder must record the following for each instance of clearing:
  - (a) the location where clearing occurred, expressed as grid coordinates using the Geocentric Datum of Australia 1994 coordinate system;
  - (b) the area cleared in hectares;
  - (c) the dates cleared;
  - (d) the method of clearing; and
  - (e) the purpose of clearing.
3. The Permit Holder shall provide a report to the Director, Environment Division, Department of Industry and Resources by 30 June 2008, demonstrating adherence to all the Conditions of this permit and setting out the records required under Condition 2 of this permit, in relation to clearing carried out between 22 March 2008 and 30 June 2008.
