PURPOSE FOR WHICH THE CLEARING MAY BE DONE

Clearing for the purpose of geotechnical investigations.

CONDITIONS

1. The Permit Holder must not clear more than 0.004 hectares, within the areas hatched yellow on attached Plan 2275/1.
2. Revegetation
 - (a) The Permit Holder shall stockpile the vegetative material and topsoil cleared in accordance with this permit.
 - (b) Within one month of the area no longer being required for the purpose of geotechnical investigations the permit holder must *revegetate* the area by, laying vegetative material and topsoil retained in accordance with condition 2(a) on the area.
2. Records to be kept
The Permit Holder must maintain the following records for activities done pursuant to this Permit, as relevant:
 - (a) In relation to the clearing of native vegetation undertaken pursuant to the purpose of clearing:
 - (i) The location where the clearing occurred, recorded using Geocentric Datum Australia 1994;
 - (ii) The date that the area was cleared; and
 - (iii) The size of the area cleared (in hectares)
3. Reporting
The Permit Holder must provide to the CEO, on or before 30 June of each year, a written report of records requested under condition 2 and activities done by the Permit Holder under this Permit between 1 January and 31 December of the preceding year.

DEFINITIONS

The following meanings are given to terms used in this Permit:

revegetate/ed/ion means the re-establishment of a cover of native vegetation in an area such that the species composition, structure and density is similar to pre-clearing vegetation types in that area;
