
Clearing for the purpose of a waste water treatment plant and pipeline installation

### **CONDITIONS**

1. The Permit Holder must not clear more than 2.6 hectares of native vegetation within the area cross-hatched yellow on attached Plan 2281/1a, 2281/1b and 2281/1c.
2. In determining the amount of native vegetation to be cleared for the purpose of waste water treatment plant and pipeline installation the Permit Holder must have regard to the following principles, set out in order of preference:
  - (a) avoid the clearing of native vegetation;
  - (b) minimise the amount of native vegetation to be cleared; and
  - (c) reduce the impact of clearing on any environmental value.
3. The Permit Holder must maintain the following records in relation to the clearing of native vegetation undertaken pursuant to the purpose of clearing:
  - (a) The location where the clearing occurred, recorded using Geocentric Datum Australia 1994;
  - (b) The date that the area was cleared; and
  - (c) The size of the area cleared (in hectares).

4. Reporting

The Permit Holder must provide to the CEO, on or before 30 June of each year, a written report of records requested under condition 3 and activities done by the Permit Holder under this Permit between 1 January and 31 December of the preceding year.
