PURPOSE FOR WHICH THE CLEARING MAY BE DONE

1. Clearing for the purposes of constructing groundwater monitoring bores and access tracks.

CONDITIONS

1. The Permit Holder must not clear more than 1.24 hectares of native vegetation. All clearing must be within the area cross-hatched yellow on attached Plan 2285/1.
2. At least once in each 12 month period for the term of this Permit, the Permit Holder must remove or kill all weeds growing within areas cleared under this Permit.
3. The Permit Holder shall record the following for each instance of clearing:
 - (a) the location where clearing occurred, expressed as grid coordinates using the Geocentric Datum of Australia 1994 coordinate system;
 - (b) the area cleared in hectares;
 - (c) the dates cleared; and
 - (d) the purpose of the clearing.
4. The Permit Holder shall provide a report to the Director, Environment, Department of Industry and Resources by 30 June each year for the life of the permit, demonstrating adherence to all the Conditions of this permit and setting out the records required under condition 2 of this permit in relation to clearing carried out between 1 July and 30 June the previous year.
