VEGETATION CONSERVATION NOTICE

Land to which this vegetation conservation notice relates ("the land"):

The whole of Lot 13895 on Deposited Plan 205461 as comprised on Certificate of Title Volume LR3084 Folio 450.

Reasons for which this vegetation conservation notice is given:

This vegetation conservation notice is given because I suspect on the following grounds that unlawful clearing has taken place, and is likely to take place on the land:

- (a) A site inspection by inspectors on 24 January 2008 of Lot 13895 on Deposited Plan 205461 observed that part of the land had been cleared after clearing permit application CPS 481/1 was refused by the CEO on 25 November 2005.
- (b) Further unlawful clearing of Lot 13895 on Deposited Plan 205461 would be necessary to implement the proposal described in clearing permit application CPS 481/1.

Requirements of this vegetation conservation notice:

The persons to whom this vegetation conservation notice is given and each owner and occupier of the land who is bound by this vegetation conservation notice is required to ensure that no unlawful clearing, or no further unlawful clearing, takes place on the land.

- Any other person who disagrees with a requirement contained in this vegetation conservation notice
 may within 21 days of the making of that requirement lodge with the Minister for the Environment
 an appeal in writing setting out the grounds of that appeal.

PENDING THE DETERMINATION OF AN APPEAL REFERRED TO ABOVE, THE RELEVANT REQUIREMENTS CONTAINED IN THIS VEGETATION CONSERVATION NOTICE CONTINUE TO HAVE EFFECT.
