### PURPOSE FOR WHICH THE CLEARING MAY BE DONE

Clearing for the purpose of road widening.

### CONDITIONS

1. The Permit Holder must not clear more than 0.4ha of native vegetation, within the areas hatched yellow on attached Plan 2520/1.
2. Avoid, minimise etc clearing  
In determining the amount of native vegetation to be cleared for the purpose of road widening the Permit Holder must have regard to the following principles, set out in order of preference:
  - (a) avoid the clearing of native vegetation;
  - (b) minimise the amount of native vegetation to be cleared; and
  - (c) reduce the impact of clearing on any environmental value.
3. Records must be kept  
The Permit Holder must maintain the following records for activities done pursuant to this Permit, as relevant in relation to the clearing of native vegetation undertaken pursuant to the purpose of clearing:
  - (a) The species composition, structure and density of the cleared area;
  - (b) The location where the clearing occurred, recorded using Geocentric Datum Australia 1994;
  - (c) The date that the area was cleared; and
  - (d) The size of the area cleared (in hectares).
4. Reporting
  - (a) The Permit Holder must provide to the CEO, on or before 30 June of each year, a written report of records required under condition 3 and activities done by the Permit Holder under this Permit between January and 31 December of the preceding year.
  - (b) Before the expiry of the permit, the permit holder must provide to the CEO a written report of records required under condition 3 where these records have not already been provided under condition 4 (a).
