**Permit to Clear Native Vegetation under the *Environmental Protection Act 1986*
Shark Bay Resources Pty Ltd – Mineral Production (CPS 2594/1)**

If you choose to appeal, it must be in writing, clearly setting out the grounds of your appeal, and received by the Minister for the Environment; Youth within **28** days of being notified. Third parties may also appeal against the issue of this permit. **Please note that clearing must not commence until the date stated on the permit (8 November 2008) or until notified on the outcome of any appeal. In addition, clearing must not commence until all other environmental approvals have been obtained.**

Under Condition 7 of your permit to clear native vegetation you are required to submit a clearing permit report. This clearing report should be forwarded to the Director, Environment Division, Department of Industry and Resources, 100 Plain Street East Perth, prior to the due date.

Compliance with the terms, conditions or restrictions of this permit does not absolve the Permit Holder from responsibility for compliance with the requirements of all Commonwealth and State legislation.
