AUTHORISED ACTIVITY

Clearing of up to 0.1 hectare of native vegetation within the area hatched yellow on attached Plan 2687/1.

CONDITIONS

Dieback and Weed Control

- When undertaking any clearing, or other activity pursuant to this Permit the Permit Holder must take the following steps to minimise the risk of introduction and spread of dieback:
 - clean earth-moving machinery of soil and vegetation prior to entering and leaving the area to be
 - (ii) avoid the movement of soil in wet conditions;
 - (iii) ensure that no dieback-affected soil, fill or other material is brought into an area that is not affected by dieback; and
 - (iv) restrict the movement of machines and other vehicles to the limits of the areas to be cleared.
- (b) When undertaking any clearing, or other activity pursuant to this Permit the Permit Holder must take the following steps to minimise the risk of the introduction and spread of weeds:
 - clean earth-moving machinery of soil and vegetation prior to entering and leaving the area to be (i)
 - (ii) ensure that no weed-affected soil, fill or other material is brought into the area to be cleared; and
 - (iii) restrict the movement of machines and other vehicles to the limits of the areas to be cleared.

DEFINITIONS

The following meanings are given to terms used in this Permit:

dieback means the effect of Phytophthora species on native vegetation;

fill means material used to increase the ground level, or fill a hollow;

term means the duration of this Permit, including as amended or renewed;

weed/s means a species listed in Appendix 3 of the Environmental Weed Strategy published by the Department of Conservation and Land Management (1999), and plants declared under section 37 of the Agricultural and Related Resources Protection Act 1976.
