## 3. Assessment of application against clearing principles

#### Comments

The clearing of 0.4 hectares of native vegetation is for the purpose of stockpile recovery for rehabilitation of disturbed areas. The proposed clearing is within mining lease ML111. The area under application is impacted by access roads and previous mining activities and consist of secondary regrowth less than 20 years old and is likely to contain a high density of weeds.

Given the disturbance to the vegetation under application, the proposed clearing is not considered likely to impact on biodiversity values, nor is likely to cause appreciable land degradation, deterioration in the quality of surface or underground water or impact on nearby conservation areas.
