The permit holder is authorised to clear native vegetation subject to the following conditions of this Permit.

PART I – CLEARING AUTHORISED

1. Purpose for which clearing may be done

Clearing for the purpose of a perimeter for red crabs and weed management.

2. Land on which clearing is to be done

LOT 3066 ON DEPOSITED PLAN 50962

3. Area of Clearing

The permit holder must not clear more than 4 hectares of native vegetation within the area solid filled yellow on attached Plan 2714/1.

4. Application

This Permit allows the permit holder to authorise persons, including employees, contractors and agents of the permit holder, to clear native vegetation for the purposes of this Permit subject to compliance with the conditions of this Permit and approval from the Permit Holder.

5. Compliance with Assessment Sequence and Management Procedures

Prior to clearing any native vegetation under conditions 1, 2 and 3 of this Permit, the permit holder must comply with the Assessment Sequence and the Management Procedures set out in Part II of this Permit.

PART II – ASSESSMENT SEQUENCE AND MANAGEMENT PROCEDURES

6. Fauna management

Clearing is prohibited outside the hours of 8:00am and 3:00pm (feeding period of the Pipestrelle Bat, *Pipistrellus murrayi*).
