Clearing of native vegetation is prohibited in Western Australia except where a clearing permit has been granted or an exemption applies. A person who causes or allows unauthorised clearing commits an offence.

Part 1 Area permit to be transferred

If you have recently purchased a property or acquired a lease on a property and an existing area permit authorises clearing on the land, as the new landowner, you may transfer the permit into your name by completing this form.

A landowner can be:

- a person who holds the certificate of title
- a person who is the lessee of Crown land
- a public authority that is responsible for care of the land.
