AUTHORISED ACTIVITY

1. Clearing of up to 5 hectares of native vegetation within the area cross hatched yellow on attached Plan 323/1.

CONDITIONS

1. The permit holder shall not clear native vegetation unless actively mining the area to be cleared within six months of the clearing.
2. Fauna management
 - (a) Prior to clearing within the areas described in clearing authorised above, the areas shall be inspected by a fauna specialist who shall identify trees that contain hollows suitable to be utilised as habitat by fauna listed in the *Wildlife Conservation (Specially Protected Fauna) Notice 2005* including, but not limited to:
 - (i) White Tailed Black Cockatoo (*Calyptorhynchus baudinii* and *Calyptorhynchus latirostris*);
 - (ii) Forest Red-tailed Black-Cockatoo (*Calyptorhynchus banksii naso*)
 - (b) The Permit Holder shall ensure that any fauna identified in condition 1(a) shall only be removed and relocated by a fauna clearing person, in accordance with a licence issued by the Department of Conservation and Land Management.
3. The Permit Holder must maintain the following records for activities done pursuant to condition 2 of this Permit:
 - (i) The number of the species relocated; and
 - (ii) The number of the species identified, and that have been observed utilising the area;
 - (iii) The location and date where relocated fauna was released, using Geocentric Datum Australia 1994.
4. The Permit Holder must provide to the CEO on or before 30 June of each year, for the term of this permit, a written report of records requested under condition 3 for the period 1 January and 31 December of the preceding year.
