AUTHORISED ACTIVITY

1. Clearing of up to 5 hectares of native vegetation within the area cross hatched yellow on attached Plan 323/1.

CONDITIONS

- 1. The permit holder shall not clear native vegetation unless actively mining the area to be cleared within six months of the clearing.
- 2. Fauna management
 - (a) Prior to clearing within the areas described in clearing authorised above, the areas shall be inspected by a fauna specialist who shall identify trees that contain hollows suitable to be utilised as habitat by fauna listed in the *Wildlife Conservation (Specially Protected Fauna) Notice 2005* including, but not limited to:
 - (i) White Tailed Black Cockatoo (Calyptorhynchus baudinii and Calyptorhynchus latirostris);
 - (ii) Forest Red-tailed Black-Cockatoo (Calyptorhynchus banksii nasa)
 - (b) The Permit Holder shall ensure that any fauna identified in condition 1(a) shall only be removed and relocated by a fauna clearing person, in accordance with a licence issued by the Department of Conservation and Land Management.
- The Permit Holder must maintain the following records for activities done pursuant to condition 2 of this Permit:
 - (i) The number of the species relocated; and
 - (ii) The number of the species identified, and that have been observed utilising the area;
 - (iii) The location and date where relocated fauna was released, using Geocentric Datum Australia 1994.
- 4. The Permit Holder must provide to the CEO on or before 30 June of each year, for the term of this permit, a written report of records requested under condition 3 for the period 1 January and 31 December of the preceding year.
