AUTHORISED ACTIVITY

Clearing of up to 12 hectares of native vegetation within the area cross hatched yellow on attached Plan 359/1.

CONDITIONS

1. Prior to clearing of native vegetation the Permit Holder shall map the presents and extent of all *Phytophthora species* within the area cross hatched yellow on attached Plan 359/1.
2. The Permit Holder shall ensure that all vehicles, tools and machinery are cleaned of all visible soil and plant material before they enter the area cross hatched yellow on attached Plan CPS 359/1.
3. The Permit Holder shall slash native vegetation located within a 5- 15 meters distance from the prison perimeter fence to a height of not less than 100mm.
4. The Permit Holder shall slash native vegetation located within a 15- 50 meters distance from the prison perimeter fence to a height of not less than 300mm.
5. For the duration of the permit, the Permit Holder shall selectively remove or kill all plant species that are not native vegetation within the area cross hatched yellow on attached Plan 359/1 at least once per year in accordance with Table 1.

Species	Season	Control
<i>Ehrharta calycina</i>	Winter	Slash April/May. Spray with Fusilade 8ml/L + wetting agent when actively growing (June – Mid July)
<i>Carpobrotus edulis</i>	Dec-Jul	Hand Pull
<i>Pelargonium capitatum</i>	Dec-Jul	Hand Pull
<i>Gladiolus caryophyllaceous</i>	August	Wipe individual leaves with Glyphosate 10% when just flowering
<i>Gazania linearis</i>	Winter	Spot Spray with Glyphosate
<i>Avena barbata</i>	Winter	Spray at 3-5 leaf stage with Fusilade 10ml/L + wetting agent
<i>Pennisetum setaceum</i>	Winter	Slash at beginning of winter followed by Glyphosate 1% + penetrate

6. The Permit Holder shall establish and maintain native vegetation species specified in Table 2 within the area cross hatched yellow on attached Plan 359/1 to minimise wind erosion of exposed soil. The planting's shall be at the densities outlined in table 2.
7. The Permit Holder shall ensure that all cuttings and seed collection for revegetation in the area cross hatched yellow on attached Plan 359/1 is obtained from Bush Forever Site 273.

8. The Clearing Permit holder shall, by the 30 November 2006, develop a bushland management plan for Bush Forever Site 273 the will include but not necessarily be limited to:
 - Flora and Vegetation Survey of Bush Forever Site 273;
 - Fauna Habitat Survey of Bush Forever Site 273;
 - Bushland condition assessment of Bush Forever Site 273;
 - Provide recommendations and timelines for the management of Bush Forever site 273; and
 - Highlight the relevant government authorities responsible for the implementation of the bushland management plan recommendations.
