



Application for a clearing permit (area permit)

Environmental Protection Act 1986 s 51E

Clearing of native vegetation is prohibited in Western Australia except where a clearing permit has been granted or an exemption applies. A person who causes or allows unauthorised clearing commits an offence.

FORM C1

Part 1 Applicant

An area permit is required to clear a particular area of native vegetation unless an exemption applies.

To apply for a permit you must either be:

- the owner of the land
- acting on the owner's behalf, or
- likely to become the owner of the land.
